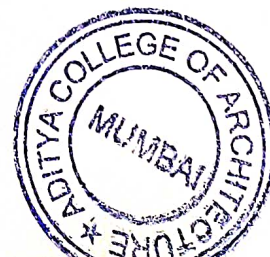

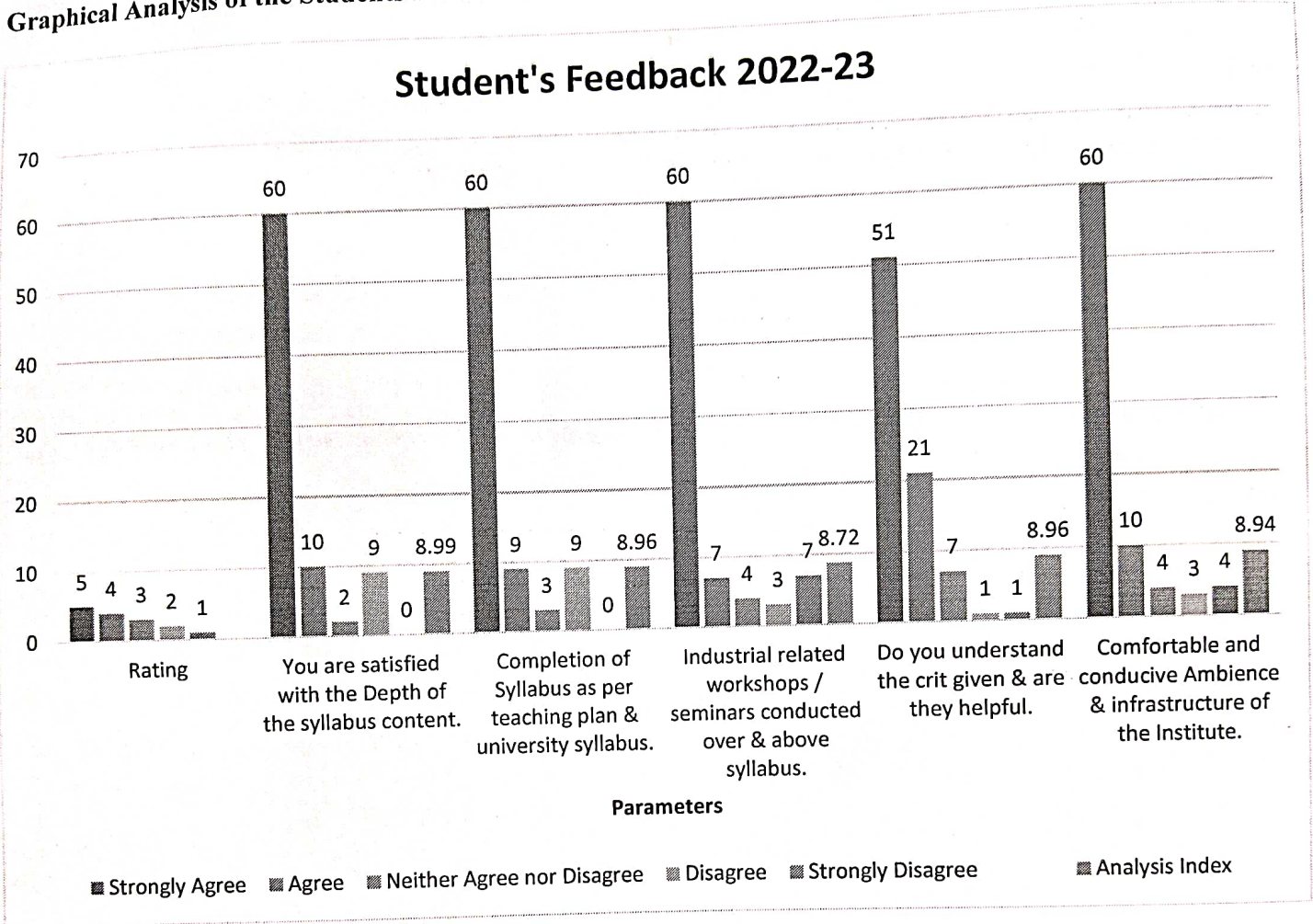

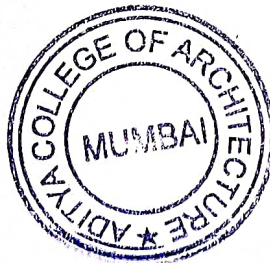
Graphical Analysis of the Students feedback:

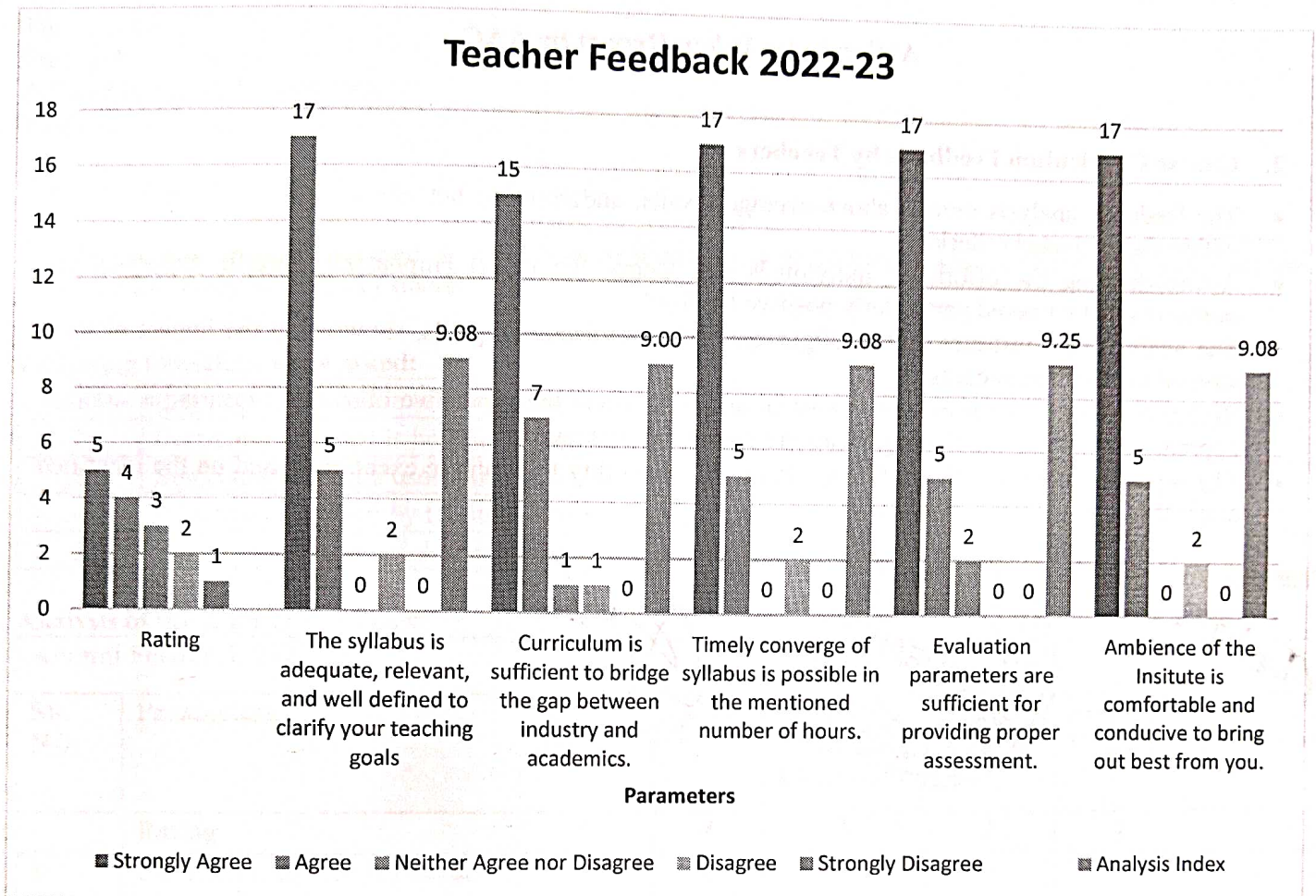

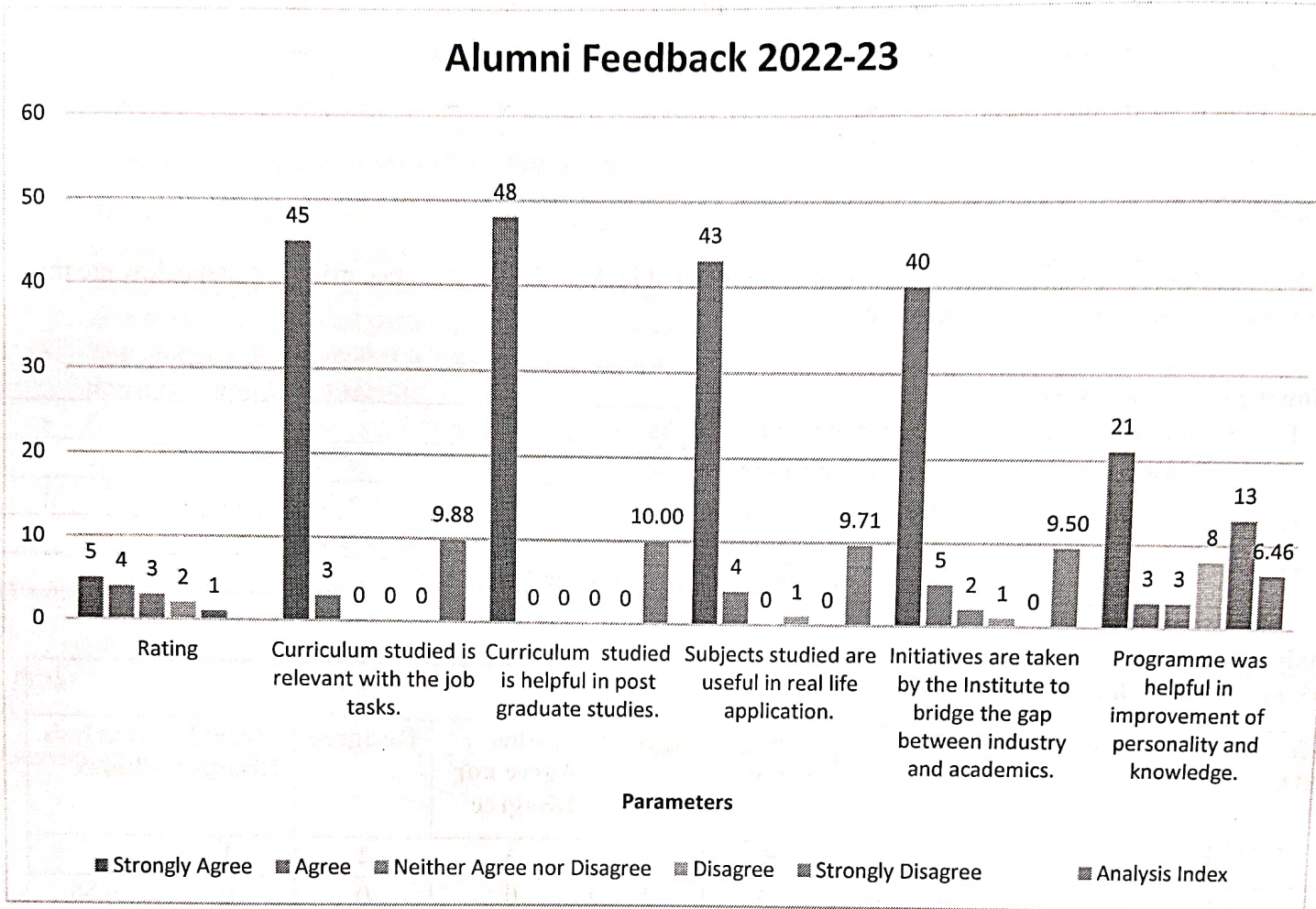

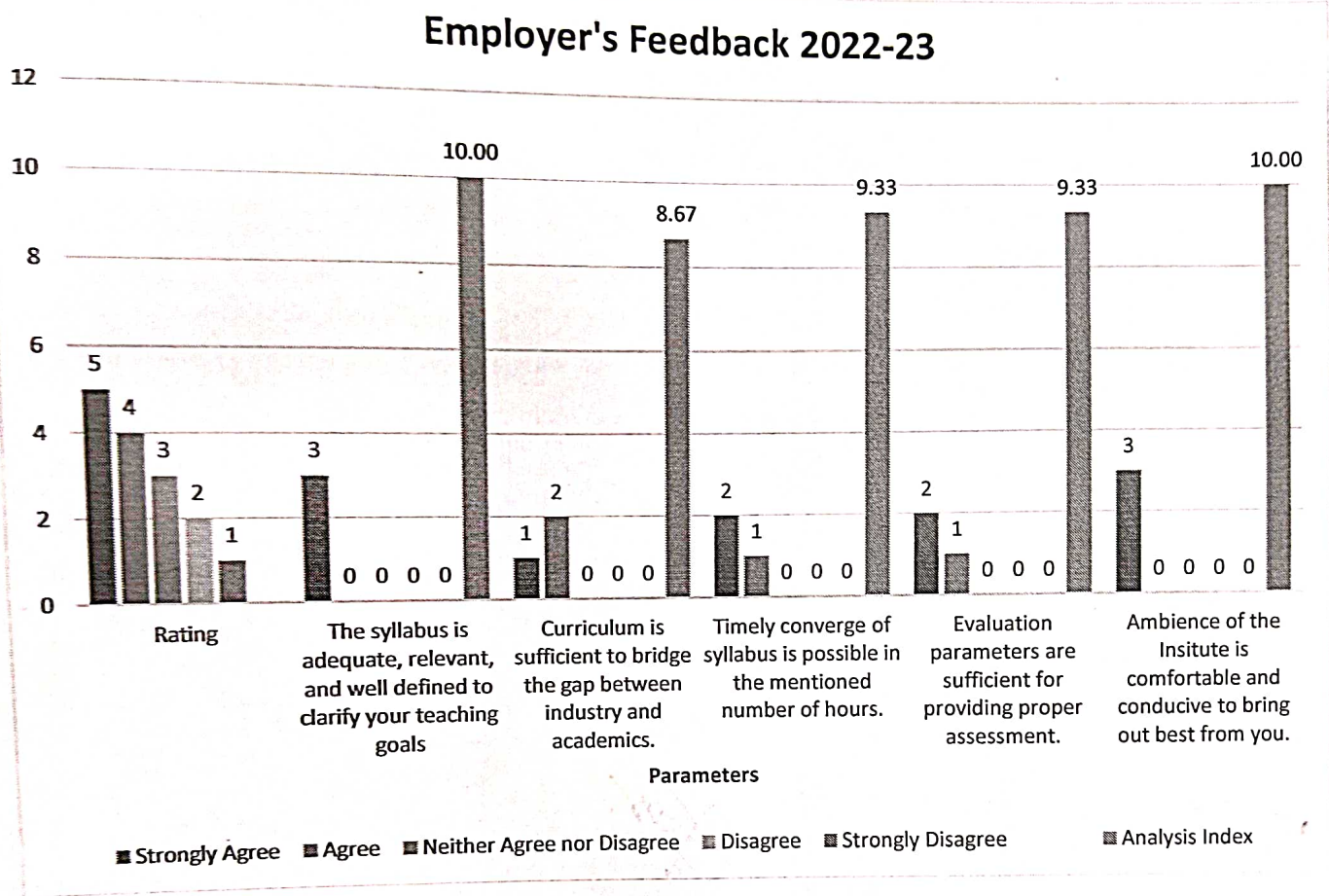
